

2010 7th Annual “Poor Charley’s Doubles” Tournament

1. All entrants must be USBC Certified Bowlers. Certification cards must be shown at time of registration. Eligible participants who are not USBC members can qualify prior to participation, by one of two ways:
 - a. By paying the appropriate affiliate membership dues.
 - b. By paying a participation fee (Rule 300c).
2. Bowlers may enter as many times as they wish, but can only cash with the same partner once.
3. Handicap will be 90% of 450 in both divisions. Above 450 – no handicap will be given.
4. Entering averages:
 - a. 2008-2009 highest USBC league average of 21 or more games.
 - b. If no last year average, use the highest current season USBC average at the time of entry for 12 games or more.
 - c. Bowlers with neither of the above averages must bowl scratch (Men use 225 – women use 220).
 - d. Rules 319c will be in effect.
5. If current season average of at least 12 games at time of bowling exceeds last seasons average by 10 or more pins, current season average will be used (Rule 319a, Item 2). If a bowler has been re-rated with the last 24 months, then the re-rate average is used if higher than book average.
6. Reporting of previous tournament prize winnings will apply (Rule 319d).
7. It is bowler’s responsibility to verify the accuracy of their own average in this tournament, whether originally submitted by the bowler, team captain, or others. Failure to use the correct average will disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average, if it is higher than the correct average (Rule 319a, Item 3).
8. The average adjustment rule will apply (Rule 319e).
9. Teams can be made up of men, women, or combination. There will be two (2) Divisions: Regular and Seniors (50 & over on date of bowling).
10. All decisions of the Tournament Manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329. USBC rules will be observed.
11. Entries must be submitted with total fees. Money orders or checks from local banks only.
RETURNED CHECKS WILL BE CHARGED \$35.00. Prize fund will be returned 100%with at least 1 in 5 payout.
